HEALTH & SAFETY POLICY STATEMENT

- The policy will be brought to the attention of all employees who will be consulted to help develop positive attitudes and behaviour towards Health and Safety.
- The Joseph Gallagher Group Ltd will conduct regular reviews to monitor performance and produce plans for improvement.
- Competent and qualified Safety Advisors shall be appointed by The Joseph Gallagher Group Ltd to assist the management in discharging its duties.
